- CICP exam on 16th March. The last date to enroll is 29th Feb.

- Submit a short CV highlighting your participation/ achievements in IPC & AMS activities (pdf format to be attached in the specified area in the application link).
- Submit the CAHO CICP exam certificate OR share the evidence of successful examination clearance.

PROCEEDINGS AFTER APPLICATION

- Candidates will be shortlisted based on the application, by an impartial selection committee.
- The shortlisted candidates will be contacted for further proceedings, to make the fee payment (Rs 5000/-).
- Upon completion of formalities, a detailed program schedule will be shared with the participants.
- Participants with a successful completion and post test score ≥80% will be empanelled as iCOMPLY auditors.
